#PierPledge

This is your unique opportunity to own a part of the 122-year-old Shotley Pier.

Built by the Marquis of Bristol in 1894, Shotley Pier was originally used for an improved ferry service between Shotley, Harwich and Felixstowe. It had hoped the pier could be used to link the postal route between England and the Hook of Holland and so was built as a railway pier.

Not only did the pier carry mail, which was sorted at the post office at the top of Bristol Hill, but later it ferried munitions down the rail tracks to nearby HMS Ganges. More recently it was used by fishermen and leisure craft as well as locals strolling to the end to enjoy wonderful views down the river Stour and across to Harwich and Felixstowe.

A community group has been formed in order to buy, renovate and preserve the pier for future generations. We are now in the process of putting together a community share issue so we can buy the pier, currently priced at £100,000, and then raise capital so we can repair the pier to make it completely safe and then renovate it back to its Victorian glory. It is estimated we will need a further £250,000 to £300,000 to complete the work, which will be done in phases so we can start making use of the pier as soon as possible.

The pledge form is aimed at gauging how much can be raised through selling community shares, at a minimum of £25 and then multiples thereof.

There will also be an opportunity to buy commemorative plaques, priced at £80, £150 and £250 and for local businesses to sponsor plaques for £1,000
